The Minister of Higher Education hereby announces to the general public and prospective applicants that the British High Commission is launching the Chevening scholarships scheme for the 2016/2017 academic year.

This scholarship is open to outstanding professionals with strong leadership potentials and academic excellence, to pursue a Master' degree program at any UK university of their choice in the following fields:

- Security and Peace (International Security/Security Management/Terrorism/Regional Development/Conflict Resolution/Peace Health/Wild life Protection);
- Prosperity (Engineering/Economics/Trade/Governance/Development/Creativity and Innovation/Entrepreneurship);
- Human Rights/Freedom of Expression (Media Law/Political Communication/Women's Rights/LGBT/ Rule of Law);
- Governance and Rule of Law.

To be eligible for a Chevening Scholarship you must:

- Be a Cameroonian citizen (Chevening-eligible country);
- Return to your country of citizenship for a minimum of two years after your scholarship has ended;
- Have an undergraduate degree that will enable you to gain entry to a post-graduate programme at a UK university. This is typically equivalent to an upper second-class 2:1 honours degree in the UK;
- Have at least two years work experience;

- Apply to three different eligible UK university courses and have received an unconditional offer from one of these choices by 14 July 2016;
- Meet the Chevening English language requirement by 14 July 2016.

The latest date for applications to be submitted is 3rd November 2015.
