


The Department of Didactics (DID)

Created on May 14, 2014, the Department of Didactics is a response to the ever growing demands of education practitioners and actors seeking a training tailored to suit their ambitions and who may want to effect changes in the education sector.

Built upon the BMD system, the department consists of three cycles namely:

The Bachelor's Level: here, students are trained to obtain a Bachelor's Degree in Education with a major in subject didactics. The training merges both theoretical knowledge and practical know-how. These skills are acquired through internships at various levels: school milieu, community and work place.

The second and third cycles offer a diversity of fields of study. A highly dynamic and qualified team of lecturers (emeritus professors, senior lecturers, assistant lecturers) supervise students in their Master's and Doctoral works. Research and mentoring of students is heightened by multilateral and bilateral partnership with national and international bodies including UNESCO, home-based and foreign universities, etc.

Master's Degree in Education with specialisation in Didactics

Objectives

- This training, that enables students to acquire a body of knowledge, procedures and methods; aims at empowering students to define a research objective, build up theoretical frameworks of reference, use appropriate methodology in educational research.
- The training revolves around theoretical contributions and convincing results in the design and conduct of research in didactics.
- The training offers students the opportunity to acquire cross curricular skills: mastery of languages (French and English), qualitative and quantitative data processing and analysis, scientific survey methods, and communication practices. These expected competences are necessary for the students to conduct a research project. The appropriation of these skills is integrative throughout the training.

Job Prospects

Graduates in Didactics can become:

- Trainers in various directorates in charge of training in ministries;
- Expert designer / counsellors in education;
- Educational research engineers;
- Education counsellors in communities;
- Experts in the design and evaluation of didactic materials;
- Pedagogic counsellors, principals, pedagogic inspectors.

Admission requirements

Admission into Master's 1 (MI) depends on results obtained in the Bachelor's cycle and places available. Prospective candidates must be holders of a Bachelor's degree or any equivalent diploma in any of the following subjects:

Languages and Literature: English Modern Letters/English Studies, French Modern Letters, Bilingual Letters, Classical Languages, Applied Linguistics, Linguistics and African Languages, German, Spanish.

Humanities: Philosophy, History, Geography

Core Sciences: Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Computer Sciences, Biology, Microbiology, Biochemistry, Earth Sciences

Admission into Master's 2 (M II) depends on the grade obtained in Master's 1 and the scrutiny of candidates files.

PhD in Education with specialisation in Didactics

Admission of candidates into PhD is based on the grades obtained in Master's II and scrutiny of files.
