Mindful of decree No. 75/780 of 18 December 1975 to lay down the Special Rules and Regulations of the corps of Statisticians;

Mindful of decree No. 94/199 of 7 October 1994 on the General Rules and Regulations of the Public Service as amended and supplemented by decree No. 2000/287 of 12 October 2000;

Mindful of decree No. 2011/408 of 09December 2011 to organize the Government; Mindful of decree No. 2011/410 of 09 December 2011 to form the Government;

Mindful of decree No. 2012/537 of 19November 2012 to organize the Ministry of the Public Service and Administrative Reform:

Mindful of decree No. 2000/696/PM of 13 September 2000 to fix the General System of Government Competitive Examinations;

Considering letter No. 2015-351/IFORD/DE/DEF of 19 November 2015 from the Executive Director of IFORD Yaounde announcing an entrance competitive examination to recruit students into his institution, for the 2016 session,

HEREBY ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

- <u>Article 1</u>.- (1) A training competitive examination to recruit students in the first year of the Professional Master Program in Demography into the Institute of Demographic Training and Research (IFORD) Yaounde has been announced for the 2016-2017 academic year.
- (2) The said competitive examinations shall take place at the Yaoundé examination centre exclusively on 30 and 31 March 2016.
 - (3) The number of available places for absorption into the Public Service after training shall be distributed as follows:
 - 10 (ten) places for Option "A";
 - 10 (ten) places for Option "B".

<u>Article 2</u>.- The examination shall be open to all young Cameroonians of both sexes who fulfill the following conditions:

A-OPTION A

- a) Be at least 17 and at most 31 years of age as at 1stJanuary 2016 (born between the 01/01/1999 and the 01/01/1985);
- b) Be holder of a first degree in any of the following disciplines:
 - Demography;
 - Geography;
 - Sociology;Anthropology;
 - Or any equivalent certificate recognized.

Article 3.- Candidates shall compile two complete application files and deposit them, against a receipt, at the Ministry of the Public Service and Administrative Reform, Department of State Human Resources Development (room 405), latest 25 March 2016. The files shall comprise the following documents:

A -IFORD FILE

- An application form obtainable at the Ministry of the Public Service and Administrative Reform;
- a personal information sheet certified by a recognized civil authority;
- a certified true copy of birth certificate certified by a recognized civil authority;
- a certified true copy of required certificate, signed by a recognized civil authority;
- 1 (one) passport size photographs.

B - PUBLIC SERVICE FILE

- a registration form bearing a CFA 1000 fiscal stamp. The forms can be obtained at the Ministry of the Public Service and Administrative Reform;
- a certified true copy of birth certificate signed by a recognized civil authority;
- an attestation of presentation of the original of the certificate signed by a competent civil authority;
- a certified true copy of the required certificate signed by a recognized civil authority;
- a receipt attesting payment of a registration fee of CFA 15000 francs(fifteen thousand) for external candidates and CFA 20000 francs (twenty thousand) for internal candidates issued by the Service Head of Direct Competitive and Scholarship Examinations of the Ministry of the Public Service and Administrative Reform (Department of State Human Resource Development);
- a certificate of non-conviction;
- a medical certificate issued by a public sector Medical Officer;
- an authenticated copy of the absorption decision for civil servant of the corps of Statistics candidates;
- an authorization signed by the Minister of the Public Service and Administrative Reform for civil servant of the corps of Statistics candidates.

N.B:

- Incomplete or late files or files containing documents not signed by a recognized civil authority shall be automatically rejected.
- All documents certified by a competent civil, municipal or legal authorities should not be more than 3 (three) months old.
- Foreign resident candidates can equally submit their files which shall comprise only documents required by IFORD.

Article 4.- (1) The competitive examination which shall take place at the Yaounde center exclusively shall be conducted following the timetable below:
