

ORDER N° 116 - 0657 /MINESUP OF 25 JUL 2016
 to launch the competitive entrance examination into the year one of the second cycle of the Higher Teacher Training College of The University of Bamenda, Bambili, for the 2016/2017 academic year.

THE MINISTER OF HIGHER EDUCATION,

- Mindful of the Constitution;
- Mindful of Law n° 2001/005 of 16 April 2001 bearing on the orientation of Higher Education;
- Mindful of Decree n° 2010/371 of 14 December 2010 creating The University of Bamenda;
- Mindful of Decree n° 2010/372 of 14 December 2010 upgrading ENSAB into the Higher Teachers' Training College (ENS) & Higher Technical Teachers' Training College (ENSET);
- Mindful of Decree n° 2011/045 of 8 March 2011 to organize The University of Bamenda
- Mindful of Decree n° 2011/408 of 9 December 2011 to organize the Government ;
- Mindful of Decree n° 2011/410 of 9 December 2011 to appoint members of Government;
- Mindful of Decree n° 2012/433 of 1st October 2012 to organise the Ministry of Higher Education;
- Mindful of Order n° 16/0172/MINESUP/SG/DAUQ/SDEAC/SE of 10 February 2016 fixing the calendar of the competitive examinations into the Cameroon States Universities for 2016-2017 academic year;
- Mindfull of Circular n° 004/CAB/PM of 10 February 2000 relating to admission into National Training Colleges and recruitment into the Public Service,

ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1: A competitive entrance examination into year one of the second cycle of the Higher Teacher Training College (HTTC) of The University of Bamenda, Bambili, has been launched for the 2016/2017 academic year, in the following Departments:

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Article 2: (1) The examination shall be organised in one sitting to Cameroonians of both sexes following the conditions stipulated below:

- General Education Teacher Section: candidates must be holders of a Bachelor Degree or *Licence* in the discipline of the relevant Department, or any equivalent diploma recognized by the Ministry of Higher Education;
- Teacher-Trainer Section: candidates must be holders of a Bachelor Degree in the relevant discipline or any equivalent diploma recognized by the Minister of Higher Education or holders of a Bachelor of Education Degree;
- Counsellor Section: candidates must be holders of any Bachelor Degree, *Licence* or any equivalent diploma recognized by the Ministry of Higher Education.

(2) Candidates who are not civil servants shall not be older than 32 years of age on 1st January 2016. No exemption shall be granted.

(3) Foreign candidates may be authorised to sit the examination under the same academic conditions depending on the number of places available and in conformity with the regulations in force.

Article 3: The application files shall comprise the following documents:

- The Examination Registration Form to be collected from HTTC Bambili, the ten Regional Delegations of Secondary Education and websites <http://www.minesup.gov.cm> and <http://www.httcbambili.com/>
- A typed certified true copy of the birth certificate dated no more than six (6) months;
- A photocopy of the birth certificate.
- Transcripts of levels I, II and III of the Bachelor Degree or *Licence* results certified by the competent academic authority of the candidate's University;
- A certified true copy of Bachelor Degree or *Licence* or any equivalent diploma recognized by MINESUP dated no more than six(6) months;
- A medical certificate issued by a medical officer from the Administration and testifying to the candidate's fitness.
- A certificate of non-conviction dated no more than three (3) months;
- A receipt upon payment of twenty thousand (20,000) FCFA as examination registration fee delivered by NFC BANK S.A: Account N°0301730101738719 or ENS MTN MOBILE MONEY Account N° 71888452. No other form of payment shall be accepted;
- One large self-addressed envelope bearing stamps in conformity with the regulations in force;
- Two passport-size photographs;
- An authorisation to sit for the examination issued by the Minister of Basic Education, the Minister of Secondary Education or the Minister of Higher Education for civil servants working in these Ministries.

Article 4: Holders of foreign diplomas/certificates shall submit either a certified true copy of the ministerial order granting equivalence or the receipt showing that they have deposited an application for equivalence in the Ministry of Higher Education. These documents must be issued by the Minister of Higher Education. Such candidates can be finally admitted into HTTC only if they are granted equivalence for their diplomas/certificates within the deadline set by the competent authority

Article 5: Complete files should be submitted to HTTC Bambili (Admissions Office) and the ten (10) Regional Delegations of Secondary Education, latest Friday, 26 August 2016.



Article 6 : (1) The examination shall comprise:

- a. Study of the Candidate's Academic file (30% of the total assessment);
- b. One written paper with Section 1, Major Paper and Section 2, Minor Paper (60% of the total assessment);
- c. An oral test (10% of the total assessment).

(2) The academic profile shall only be taken into account after the oral test, for final admission.

Article 7: The written paper will take place on Saturday, 3 September 2016 in the following examination centres: Bambili, Bafoussam, Buea, Douala, Ngaoundéré and Yaoundé.

Article 8: The written paper shall comprise forty (40) Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs) in Section 1 for the Major Paper and twenty (20) Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs) in Section 2 for the Minor Paper, except for Bilingual Letters and English Modern Letters, as specified for these Departments in the table below:

(1) The syllabuses of the competitive entrance examination are the same as for the Bachelor Degree or *Licence* syllabuses.

(2) Marks for the written test shall range from zero to forty (0–40) for section 1 and from zero to twenty (0 –20) for section 2, or zero to thirty (0-30) for both sections as the case may be.

(3) The Jury shall publish the list of successful candidates in the written papers per Department and in alphabetical order. Successful candidates in the written part shall proceed to the oral test.

Article 9: The oral test shall take place exclusively in the Bambili Centre. Questions for the oral test will cover two areas namely, General Knowledge and Bilingual Orientation.

Article 10: The study of academic profile (See Article 6) shall take into consideration:

- The candidate's age;
- The number of years spent in the University for the First Degree;
- The grade obtained for the Bachelor Degree or Licence.

Article 11: After the oral test, the Jury shall prepare the list of successful candidates per Department and by order of merit and submit the final results in strict confidence to the Minister of Higher Education, who shall publish them.



Article 12: Successful candidates shall not, under any circumstance, defer their registration to the following academic year.

Article 13: The composition of the Jury shall be specified by the Minister of Higher Education in conformity with the rules and regulations in force.

Article 14: Registration fees as stipulated in Article 3 shall not be refundable.

Article 15: The Vice-Chancellor of The University of Bamenda, the Director of University Accreditation and Quality Control and the Director of the Higher Teacher Training College, Bambili, each in his/her own sphere, are responsible for the implementation of this Order which shall be registered and published in English and French wherever necessary./-
