To launch the competitive entrance examination for admission into the B.Sc. Programme in Midwifery in the Faculty of Health Sciences of the University of Buea and to fix the number of places available for the 2016/2017 academic year.

of law no 005 of 16th April 2001 on the orientation of Higher Education; Mindful of decree no 2004/320 of 08th December 2004 to organize the government; Mindful of decree no 2004/322 of 08th December 2004 to appoint the members of government; Mindful of Decree n° 2015/434 of 02 October 2015 to reshuffle the Government; Mindful Mindful of decree n° 2005/142 of 29th April 2005 to organize the Ministry of Higher Education; of decree no 92/074 of 13th April 1992 to transform the Buea and Ngaoundere University Mindful Centres into Universities; of Decree No. 93/026 of 19th January 1993 to create universities; Mindful of decree no 93/034 of 19 January 1993 to organize the University of Buea; Mindful of Decree nº 2005/344 of 10 September, 2005 appointing Rectors and The Vice Chancellorof Mindful Universities: of decree no 2012/333 of 29th June 2012 to appoint the Vice-Chancellor of the University Mindful of Buea: of decree no 93/027 of 19th January 1993 to lay down provisions common to all Mindful Universities, modified and completed by decree no 2005/342 of 10th September 2005; of order no 16/0172 MINESUP/SG/DDAQ/SDEAC/SE 10th February 2016 stipulating the Mindful calendar of activities for competitive entrance examinations into State Universities in Cameroon for the 2016-2017 academic year;

HEREBY DECIDES AS FOLLOWS:

the Proposal of the Vice-Chancellor of the University of Buea;

Article 1: The Entrance Examination for the admission of 40 (forty) students into the first year, of the Bachelor of Science degree programme in Midwifery in the Faculty of Health Sciences of the University of Buea for the 2015/2016 academic year will take place on Friday 09th and Saturday 10th September 2016 at the Faculty of Health Sciences campus of the University of Buea.

Article 2: The entrance examination into the Bachelor of Science degree programme in Midwifery is opened to all Cameroonian and foreign candidates who are holders of:

- the G.C.E. Advanced Level in at least two relevant subjects, two of which must be Biology and Chemistry (Food and Nutrition exempted), and the G.C.E. Ordinary Level in five subjects in one session including English Language and Mathematics (Religious Knowledge exempted);
- the Baccalaureat series C or D, and the Probatoire certificate series C or D



- the State Registered Midwife Certificate with GCE ordinary level passed in five papers (English language, Biology, and Mathematics inclusive) and at least two G.C.E. Advanced Level papers, one of which must be Biology.
- Holders of equivalent qualifications as determined by the Minister of Higher Education are eligible to apply.

<u>Article 3</u>: The completed application files which must be received at the Registrar's Office, University of Buea, P.O. Box 63 Buea by Friday 25th August 2016 should comprise the following documents:

• a completed application form obtainable from the office of the Registrar, University of Buea, upon presentation of a bank receipt of 20,000FCFA addressed to the "The Accounting Officer, University of Buea." This sum of money is payable to the following University of Buea bank account: BICEC Buea Account No. 100010 6842 98394742001-23.

Registration fees are not refundable.

The application form is also available on the Web Site of the Ministry of Higher Education, http/www/minesup.gov.cm.

- a certified-true copy of their birth certificate dated no more than six months.
- 2 recent passport size photographs.
- certified-true copies of certificates/diplomas
- copies of transcripts (for candidates with the Baccalaureat certificates).

Incomplete files will not be considered.

<u>Article 4</u>: The entrance examination will cover topics treated at the G.C.E. Ordinary, G.C.E. Advance Level and the Baccalaureat in the following areas:

- Biology	Coef 3
- Chemistry	Coef 2
- Physics/Midwifery science	Coef 2
- Use of English	Coef 2
- Oral Examination	Coef 1

A study of the candidate's academic background (quality of certificates and transcripts presented) shall constitute 40% (forty per cent) of the total marks of the entrance examination. The written and oral examinations shall carry the remaining 60% (sixty per cent).

<u>Article 5</u>: Candidates writing the entrance examination for the midwifery sciences programme should be at the Faculty of Health Sciences Campus of the University of Buea at least one hour before the start of the first subject, with their National identity cards or valid passports. No other form of identification will be accepted.

<u>Article 6</u>: The expenditure resulting from this decision will be charged to the budget of the University of Buea, budgetary charge 620903 for the 2016 financial year.

<u>Article 7</u>: The Vice-Chancellor of the University of Buea, the Director of University Accreditation and Quality and the Dean of the Faculty of Health Sciences are each entrusted with the implementation of this decision which shall be registered and published in English and French wherever necessary.
