Article 2.- REQUIREMENTS

These competitive examinations shall be open to all Camerbornians who fulfil the following conditions:

Fulfil all the requirements for admission to a public service employment and conditions laid down by the General Rules and Regulations of the Public Service;

a) Be 17 years of age at least and 34 years at most as at 1st January 2016 (be born between 01/01/1982 and 01/01/1999) for candidates for the 'A' and 'B' categories of the Public Service;

b) Be 17 years of age at least and 29 years at most as at 1st January 2016 (be born between 01/01/1987 and 01/01/1999) for candidates of the 'C' category of the Public Service.

Assistant Sanitary Technician, be holder of the General Certificate of Education Ordinary Level (GCE-O/L) in four papers excluding "religious knowledge" or the BEPC (Brevet d'Etudes du Premier Cycle) and a diploma of Assistant Sanitary Technician or diploma of Mortuary Attendant issued by a government national institution of training, or a recognized equivalent diploma issued by a foreign or international institution of training featuring in the list approved by an order of the Prime Ministration

Sanitary Technician, be holder of both the Probatoire certificate or the General Certificate of Education Ordinary Level (GCE-O/L) in four papers excluding "religious knowledge" and a diploma of Sanitary Technician issued by a government national institution of training, or a recognized equivalent diploma issued by a foreign or international institution of training featuring in the list approved by an order of the Prime Minister.
