To launch a competitive entrance examination for admission into the 1st year of the Advanced Professional Studies (DEPA) Cycle of the Advanced School of Economics and Commerce (ESSEC) of the University of Douala for the 2017/2018 academic year.

ORDERS:

Article 1: A competitive entrance examination for the admission of **Two Hundred and Twenty Five (225)** students into the first year of the Advanced Professional Studies (DEPA) Cycle of the Advanced School of Economics and Commerce (ESSEC) of the University of Douala for the 2017/2018 academic year is hereby launched in the options and number of places as follows:

Article 2: The examination is open to candidates of both sexes, holders of at least a Bachelor's degree or its equivalent.

The training is full-time (day classes) and is offered exclusively to non workers.

Article 3: candidates' application files include the following:

- 1- a registration form (obtainable from the Admissions Office of ESSEC, or the Department of Higher Education Development, Ministry of Higher Education, Yaoundé);
- 2- a hand-written application bearing a 1000 CFA Francs fiscal stamp;
- 3- a certified true copy of birth certificate, not older than three (3) months;
- 4- a certified true copy of Baccalauréat or GCE A/L;
- 5- a certified true copy of the Terminale or Upper 6th report cards;
- 6- a medical certificate not older than three (3) months, issued by a state registered medical practitioner;
- 7- a certificate of non-conviction issued not earlier than three (3) months ago;
- 8- two (2) recent passport size photographs of the candidate;
- 9- an authorisation to register for the competitive examination issued by the Minister of Public Service and Administrative Reform, or the competent Administrative authority, for civil servants and state agents;
- 10- the receipt issued upon payment of twenty thousand (20,000) CFA Francs on the following account: École Supérieure des Sciences Économiques et Commerciales (ESSEC), n° 14004000005, United Bank for Africa (UBA) Cameroon, University of Douala Branch;
- 11- an A-4 size self-addressed envelope bearing a 400 CFA Francs postage stamp.

Article 4: All complete application files must reach the Admissions Office of ESSEC Douala, on or before **Friday, 23th June 2017**.

WHERE TO OBTAIN REGISTRATION FORMS AND RETURN APPLICATION FILES

- Admissions Office, ESSEC ;
- Department of Accreditations and Quality, Ministry of Higher Education, Yaoundé.

Article 5: Only those candidates with complete application files shall be authorised to sit for the examination. They should bring along their national identity card.

DATE OF EXAMINATION: Friday, 30th June 2017, from 8 a.m. in the following centres: Douala (ESSEC Campus); Yaoundé (University of Yaoundé 1 Campus); Bafoussam; Garoua.

Article 6: STRUCTURE OF THE EXAMINATION: The competitive entrance examination has three (3) sections:

- A written examination representing 60 % of the final mark ;
- An examination of the candidate's school records representing 20 % of the final mark ;
- An interview (oral examination) representing 20 % of the final mark.

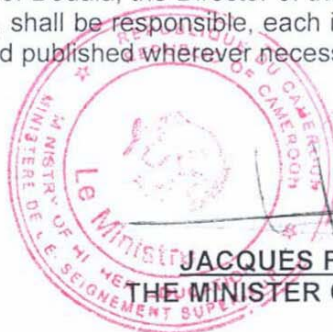
Article 7: The written examination comprises the following:

- An essay on an economic topic, aimed at testing the candidate's interest either in the national and international economic issues, or in the recent economic history or in economic geography.
- A paper on the specialized area to test the candidate's aptitudes to carry on advanced studies in the chosen speciality

Each paper lasts four (4) hours and represents 50 % of the written examination.

Article 8: For the candidates having chosen Entrepreneurship Management or Project Management, Analysis and Evaluation, the oral examination (interview) shall be mainly based on the presentation and discussion of a project initiated by the candidate.

Article 9: The Rector of the University of Douala, the Director of the Department of University Accreditations and Quality, and the Director of ESSEC, shall be responsible, each in his own sphere, for the implementation of this order which shall be registered and published wherever necessary.
