Mindful of Decree N°2012/433 of 01st 2012 October organizing the Ministry of Higher Education;

Mindful of Decree N°2018/005 of 08th January 1998 creating the Higher Teacher Training College (ENS) of Bertoua;

Mindful of Order N°18/00091/MINESUP/SG/DAUQ/SDEAC/SE of 22 February 2018 that sets up the calendar for competitive examinations into the institutions of Cameroon state universities, in the course of the 2018-2019 academic year;

Mindful of Circular N°004/CAB/PM of 10 February 2000 concerning admission into national training institutions and the recruitment into the Public Service.

ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Article 1</u>: A competitive entrance examination into Year One of the First Cycle of the Higher Teacher Training College (ENS) of Bertoua for the 2018/2019 academic year has been launched in the following series:

<u>Article 2</u>: The examination shall be organised in one sitting and is open to Cameroonians of both sexes who are holders of the "Baccalauréat" that matches the desired series.

The "Bilingual Letters" series are open to holders of GCE A/L in at least two (2) subjects including "French" and at least four (4) GCE O/L subjects excluding "Religious Knowledge".

The "Bilingual Letters" series shall be open only to holders of GCE A/L and of the Baccalaureat ABI who fulfill the rest of the conditions stipulated in the present decision.

The table below specifies the series of "Baccalaureat" and the subjects candidates must pass in the GCE A/L to be qualified to register for the competitive entrance examination in a given series:

- Article 3: (1) Foreign candidates may be allowed to sit for the examination, under the same academic conditions and according to the number of places available, in conformity with the regulations in force.
 - (2) Candidates must not be more than 28 years old by January 1st, 2018.
- (3) Candidates who are civil servants shall not be eligible to write the competitive entrance examination as external candidates.
- (4) Candidates who are fraudulently admitted without fulfilling the stipulated conditions of basic certificate, grade or age limit, shall be subject to instant dismissal at any moment without any formal procedure

Article 4: The application files shall comprise the following documents:

- A registration form available at ENS, Regional Centers, the ENS Bertoua website http://www.unregistration.univ-ndere.cm or www.ensbertoua.uninet.cm
- A certified photocopy of the birth certificate which must not be more than three (3) months old from the date of issue:
- Photocopies of transcripts of Probatoire or GCE O/L and Baccalaureat or GCE AL signed or certified by the competent boards as well as results slips;
- A certified true photocopy of Baccalaureat or GCE/AL or equivalent diploma which must not be more than three (3) months old from the date of issue. Candidates preparing for the Baccalaureat or GCE/AL for the 2016/2017 session shall present their diploma in due time;
- A medical certificate issued by medical officer, from the Administration, testifying that the candidate is physically and medically fit for teaching. It should particularly specify that the candidate does not suffer from serious physiological deficiencies in his diction, hearing, sight and mobility;
- A certificate of non-conviction which must not be more three (3) months old from the date of issue:
- A receipt of twenty thousand (20 000) FCFA as registration fee issued by SOCIETE GENERALE CAMEROUN account N°CM21 10003 00900 22090784104 86. No other form of payment is accepted;
- One A4 self-addressed (machine-stamped) envelope;
- Two passport-size photographs;
- An authorisation to sit for the examination issued by the Minister of Basic Education, the Minister of Secondary Education or the Minister of Higher Education for candidates working in these Ministries.

Article 5; Holders of foreign diplomas shall submit either the equivalence or the receipt showing that they applied for the equivalence of their diplomas or certificates. The order granting equivalence and the receipt are issued by the Minister of Higher Education. The final admission of these candidates shall be confirmed only upon presentation, within the dateline set by the competent authorities, of the text granting them equivalence.

Article 6: All the complete files must be deposited with the Coordination of the Higher Teacher Training College (ENS) of Bertoua, or in the Regional Delegations of MINESEC, SERVICES DU PREMIER MINISTRE at the latest on the 12th September 2018.

Article 7; The examination shall comprise:

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- a. Academic performance (30% of total assessment);
- b. Two written papers (70% of the total assessment);

<u>Article 8</u>: The written papers will take place on the 22nd September 2018 in the following examination centers: Bafoussam(IUT-FV), Bamenda(ENS Bambili), Bertoua(ENS, Lycée Scientifique et Lycée Bilingue), Douala(ESSEC), Ebolowa(FASA/ENSET), Garoua(Lycée Classique et Moderne), Maroua(Collège de l'Espoir), Ngaoundéré(Lycée Classique et Moderne de Ngaoundéré) and Yaoundé(ENS, Fac Sciences, ENSP),

The syllabuses of the competitive entrance examination in each section are the same as in the Baccalaureat or GCE A/L programmes for each series.

Marks for each paper of the written test range from zero to twenty according to the aforementioned coefficients. Any candidate who scores less than five on twenty shall be disqualified.

<u>Article 10</u> The study of candidates' files will be based on:

- the candidate's age;
- the number of years spent in secondary education,
- transcripts of probatoire, GCE O/L and that of baccalauréat or GCE A/L

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<u>Article 11:</u> After writing test the jury shall prepare the of successful candidates per series and by order of merit. The final results will be published by the Minister of Higher Education, Successful candidates cannot, under any circumstance, postpone their registration to the following academic year.

<u>Article 12:</u> The composition of the jury mentioned in articles 9 to 11 above shall be specified by the Minister of Higher Education in conformity with the rules and regulations in force.

Article 13: Registration fees are non-refundable.

<u>Article 14:</u> The Rector of the University of Ngaoundéré, the Director of the Department of University Accreditations and Quality, and the Director of the Higher Teacher Training College of Bertoua are responsible, each in his/her own capacity, for the implementation of this circular which shall be registered and published in English and French wherever need be.
