ORDER N° MINETAT/MINESUP/SG/DAUQ/SDEAC/SE of 31 MAI 2019

To launch a competitive entrance examination for admission into the **first year** of the Institute of Fine Arts of the University of Douala at Nkongsamba, and fixing the number of places offered for the 2019/2020 academic year.

THE MINISTER OF STATE, MINISTER OF HIGHER EDUCATION:

- Mindful of The constitution ;
Mindful of Law N° 005/2001 of 16 April 2001 bearing on Higher Education Orientation ;
Mindful of Decree N° 2018/190 of 02 March 2018 to amend and complete some provisions of Decree N°2011/408 of 09 December 2011 on the organization of the government ;
Mindful of Decree N°2011/410 of 09 December 2011 to appoint Members of Government ;
Mindful of Decree N° 2018/191 of 04 January 2019 to reshuffle the Government ;
Mindful of Decree N° 93/026 of 19 January 1993, to create Universities ;
Mindful of Decree N° 93/027 of 19 January 1993, to define provisions common to Universities, modified and completed by Decree 2005/342 of 10 September 2005 ;
Mindful of Decree N° 2005/383 of 17 October 2005 to lay down the Financial Regulations Applicable to Universities ;
Mindful of Decree N° 93/030 of 19 January 1993 to lay down the administrative and academic Organisation of the University of Douala ;
Mindful of Decree N° 93/035 of 19 January 1993 to grant Special Status to the Higher Education Staff ;
Mindful of Decree N°2015/398 of 15 September 2015, to appoint Rectors in some State Universities ;
Mindful of Order N° 19/00054/MINESUP/SG/DAUQ/SDEAC/SE of february 27, 2019 fixing the calendar for the competitive entrance examinations into the various Schools of State Universities and Schools under academic supervision of MINESUP, for the 2019/2020 academic year ;
And on the proposal of the Rector of the University of Douala ;

ORDERS:

Article 1st: A competitive entrance examination for the admission of **150 students** into the **1st year** of the Institute of Fine Arts of the University of Douala at Nkongsamba for the **2019/2020** academic year has been launched and will take place on **6th September 2019**.

Article 2 : The entrance examination, referred to in Article 1, is open to Cameroonians of both sexes, as well as to foreign applicants resident in Cameroon, within the limits of available places.

Article 3 : The distribution of the number of places is fixed as follows :

Article 4 : This entrance examination is open to applicants holding the following diplomas :

Article 5 : The requirements of Article 4 are applicable to any applicant holding any other diploma or degree recognized as equivalent by the Ministry of Higher Education.

Article 6 : The complete application form includes the following documents :

1. A hand-written application stamped at the regulatory tariff;
2. An identification form provided by the Institute of Fine Arts, available at:
 - The University of Douala (Faculty of Letters and Human Sciences: Academic Office);
 - The Institute of Fine Arts of Nkongsamba (Academic Office);
 - The Ministry of Higher Education (9th floor, door 917);
 - All the Regional Delegations of the Ministry of Secondary Education.
3. A certified copy of the birth certificate dated less than three (03) months;
4. A certified copy of the diplomas giving entitlement to the competitive entrance examination;
5. Five (05) 4x4 passport size photographs;
6. A medical certificate issued by a doctor of the administration, attesting that the applicant is able
 - to pursue university studies;
7. Transcripts of Baccalaureat or GCA L Degree;
8. A receipt for the payment of the sum of **twenty thousand** CFA francs (20,000) representing the
 - competitive entrance fee, payable to the bank **UBA** to account **N° 10033-05214-1400-7000004-47;**
9. Two (02) A4 stamped envelopes to the candidate's address;
10. An authorization to compete issued by the employer, for the civil servant applicants, workers of the private companies and the organizations.

Article 7 : Complete applications should be received latest by **September 3, 2019** at the following places :

- The University of Douala (Faculty of Letters and Human Sciences: Academic Office);

- The Institute of Fine Arts of Nkongsamba (Academic Office);
- IBA offices at the former FGI Deanship (entry ENSET of Douala at Ndogbong);
- The Ministry of Higher Education (9th floor, door 917);
- All the Regional Delegations of the Ministry of Secondary Education.

Article 8 : The written examination consists of the following papers :

Article 9 : The applicants must be at least twenty-nine (29) years old on the first of January of the competition year.

Article 10 : Civil servant applicants, workers of the private companies and the organizations are in no case concerned by the age restriction referred to in Article 9.

Article 11: An examination center is opened in the following localities:

- **Douala** (The University of Douala, Amphi 200 of ESSEC) ;
- **Nkongsamba** (The Institute of Fine Arts) ;
- **Yaoundé** (FALHS, The University of Yaounde I) ;
- **Bertoua** (Bilingual High School)
- **Maroua** (The Regional Center of Agriculture of Maroua).

Article 12: The Rector of the University of Douala, the Director of University Accreditations and Quality are, each in his capacity, responsible for the implementation of this order which shall be registered and published wherever need be.
