To launch the competitive Entrance Examination into Government Technical Teachers' Training Colleges (GTTTC), 2020 session

THE MINISTER OF SECONDARY EDUCATION,

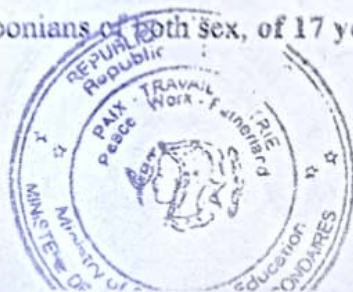

Mindful of the Decree N°80/195 of 09 June 1980 on the General Rules and Regulations of Teachers Training Colleges;
Mindful of the Decree N°2000/696/PM of 13 September 2000 to lay down the general rules and regulations for Government competitive examinations
Mindful of the Decree N°2011/408 of 09 December 2011 to organise the Government, modified and completed by the Decree N°2018/190 of 02 March 2018,
Mindful of the Decree N°2012/267 of 11 June 2012 to organise the Ministry of Secondary Education;
Mindful of the Decree N°2019/001 of 04 January 2019 appointing the Prime Minister, Head of Government;
Mindful of the Decree N°2019/002 of 04 January 2019 to reshuffle the Government;
Mindful of the Order N°202/09/MINESEC/IGE of 29 September 2009 to reorganise specialities in GTTTC;
Mindful of the Order N°225/17/MINESEC/SEESSEN/SG/IGE/IP-EN/DEN/DECC/DAJ of 07 August 2017 to organise Competitive Entrance Examination into Government Technical Teachers' Training Colleges (GTTTC);
Mindful of the Decision N°763/19/MINESEC/SEESSEN/SG/DECC/SDOEC of 16 October 2019 to define the calendar and registration procedures into Examinations supervised by the Department of Examinations and Certification, 2020 Session;
Mindful of the Decision N°782/19/MINESEC/SG/DECC/SDOEC of 28 October 2019 to define the 2020 Official Calendar of Examination;
Considering necessities of service;

DECIDES AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1: A competitive entrance examination for the recruitment of three thousand nine hundred (3 900) students-teachers into Government Technical Teacher Training Colleges of Bafoussam, Bertoua, Douala, Ebolowa, Garoua, Maroua, N'Gaoundere, and Soa for French speaking candidates, and Jikejeme, Kumba, and Mbengwi for English speaking candidates, shall take place on Monday 22 June and Tuesday 23 June 2020, in all regional capitals.

Article 2: The distribution of available places put in the appendix may be compensated if necessary.

Article 3: The examination is open to young Cameroonians of both sex, of 17 years at least and 32 years at most by 1st January 2020.



Article 4: Certificate Requirements:

Article 5: Candidates who do not meet all requirements cited in Article 4 shall be authorised to sit for the examination subject to obtaining the diploma required during the 2020 session for their final admission.

Article 6: Requirements and deadline

6.1. All Complete application files that must reach the Regional Delegations of Secondary Education (RDSE), the Sub-département of Examination and Certification, Divisional Delegations of Secondary Education (DDSE) and Service of Administrative and Financial Affairs latest Thursday 30 April 2020, shall include:

- A duly filled and stamped registration form, that the candidate can collect from RDSE/DDSE;
- A certified true copy of birth certificate not older than three (03) months (see over the registration form);
- A certified true copy of the certificate required for the Common Entrance Examination (see over the registration form) for candidate who has a certificate;
- A certificate of non-conviction not earlier than three (03) months;
- A Medical certificate not older than three (03) months, issued by a registered medical practitioner and attesting of the ability of the candidate to work as a teacher, in accordance with the regulation in force;
- Two (02) identification forms;
- Four (04) recent passport size photographs 4 x 4;
- A Certificate of Nationality;
- The ticket approving mobile payment of registration fees of CFA ten thousand (10.000), issued either by the Sub-Director of General Affairs of the RDSE or the Service Head of Administrative and Financial Affairs of the DDSE;
- A 28 x 37 stamped envelope bearing the exact address of the candidate (Postal code and telephone number).



6.2. All incomplete or late files shall be rejected.

6.3. Candidates sit for the examination in the Region where they have submitted their candidacy files, and each in their proper speciality. The school chosen is from that Region.
