To open selection test for admission into the Master of Research in International Relations, Major in Cultural Diversity, Peace and International Cooperation at the ISESCO/FUMI Chair on Cultural Diversity of the University of Yaoundé II at the International Relations Institute of Cameroon, for the 2016-2017 academic year.

THE MINISTER OF HIGHER EDUCATION HEREBY ANNOUNCES:

The selection test for admission of 35 (thirty five) candidates into the Master of Research in Cultural Diversity, Peace and International Cooperation at the ISESCO/FUMI Chair for Cultural Diversity of the University of Yaoundé II, has been launched at the International Relations Institute of Cameroon (IRIC) for the 2016-2017 academic year. The examination shall take place in the unique centre of Yaoundé.

The selection shall be done through a rigorous review of candidate's application files comprising two phases: the file review by a committee and the interview of presented candidates by the same committee.

Conditions to be fulfilled:

- Be of Cameroonian nationality (foreign candidates are admitted out of the fixed quota);

Executives of public, parastatal or local administrations in charge of issues of peace, security, diversity and/or cooperation can also submit applications.

- A registration form to be obtained from IRIC or from the websites of the Ministry of Higher Education: http/www.minesup.gov.cm or of the IRIC: www.iricuy2.net;
- A certified true copy of the candidate's birth certificate issued not more than three (03) months;
- A certified true copy of the highest certificate including transcripts certified by the competent academic authorities;
- A medical certificate;
- A passport size photography (4 x 4);
- A receipt of payment of twenty five thousand francs CFA (25.000) at the bank upon the presentation of a discharge from the Bursar's office of IRIC, representing the file study fees which are not refundable;
- A self-addressed envelope bearing a 500 FCFA postage stamp.
