To launch the competitive examination for admission into the 3rd year (Bachelor of Technology) at the University Institute of Technology (UIT) of the University of Douala and to fix the number of places available, for the 2019/2020 academic year.

ORDERS

Article 1: A competitive entrance examination for the admission into the third year of Technology Bachelor of the University Institute of Technology of the University of Douala, for the 2019/2020 academic year, shall take place on **14 september 2019**, at the single center of the IUT of Douala.

Article 2: The entrance examination referred to in article 1 above is open to Cameroonian of both sexes and to foreign candidates holding one of the following diplomas or its equivalent:

- UDT (University Diploma of Technology)

- HND (Higher National Diploma)
- Faculty Bachelor with profile in accordance with the requested option.

Article 3 : The number of available places for this entrance is equal to one thousand one hundred and sixty four (1164) standing as follows :

Article 4: The complete application file should comprise the following documents:

- 1- A registration form. This form shall be duly **completed on line** in the Web site of UIT of Douala: www.iut-douala.cm and then printed, signed by the candidate and stamped at 1000 FCFA. The 25 000 FCFA of examination fees must be paid before the online registration ;
- 2- A certified true copy of the required diploma ;
- 3- The transcripts corresponding to the two years preparatory to the diploma;
- 4- A certified true **photocopy** of birth certificate not older than three (03) months ;
- 5- A curriculum vitae;
- 6- A certificate of work (Desirable);
- 7- Two (02) recent passport size photographs of the candidate;
- 8- A **21 x 29.7 size** self-addressed envelope bearing a 400 CFA francs postal stamp;
- 9- A simple photocopy of the National Identity Card;
- 10- A **twenty five thousand (25 000)** CFA francs banking receipt being examination fees to pay at **UBA count N° 10033 05214 14004000006 - 90**;
- 11- A medical certificate not older than three (03) months issued by a state medical practitioner and testifying that the candidate is fit for higher education ;

Article 5 : The complete files should be deposited latest on 09 September 2019 in the Admissions Office of the Douala University Institute of Technology.

Application forms can also be downloaded from the website of the Ministry of Higher Education at: www.minesup.gov.cm or of the UIT of Douala www.iut-douala.cm.

Article 6 : The examination has a written paper which depends of the choice of the option.

Article 7 : A press release from the Rector of the University of Douala will specify as necessary the planning of the various papers.

Article 8 : The successful candidates shall report to UIT for registration formalities within fifteen days following the date of publication of the final results. Candidates, who fail to comply with this requirement, as need arise, shall be replaced by those on the waiting list following the order of merit, through a press release published by the Minister of Higher Education on the recommendation of the Rector of the University of Douala.

Article 9 : The Rector of the University of Douala, the Director of University Accreditations and Quality, and the Director of UIT of Douala, each in his own sphere, are responsible for the implementation of the present order which shall be registered and published in English and in French wherever necessary./-
