HEREBY ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1.- (1) A training competitive examination to recruit 25 (twenty-five) student Senior Sports and Physical Education Teachers (MPEPS) and 25 (twenty-five) student Sports and Physical Education Teachers (MEPS) into the National Youths and Sports Centres (NYSC) of Bamenda, Bertoua, Dschang and Garoua is hereby announced for the Bamenda, Bafoussam, Douala, Garoua and Yaounde centres, for the 2020/2021 academic year.

(2) The physical part of the said competitive examination shall take place on 25 and 26 August 2020 and the written part shall be conducted on 29 and 30 August 2020.

Article 2.- REQUIREMENTS.

a) General conditions:

The examinations shall be open to all Cameroonians who meet the following conditions:

- 1) fulfil the general requirements for employment into the Public Service as well as the conditions laid down by the general rules and regulations of the Public Service.
- 2) be physically fit to work as a Sports and Physical Education Teacher.
- 3) be at least 17 (seventeen) years of age and 31 (thirty-one) years of age, at most, as at 1st January 2020 (be born between 01/01/1989 and 01/01/2003) for external candidates and 40 (forty) years of age at most, as at 1st January 2020 (be born between 01/01/1980 and 01/01/2003) for internal candidates.

b) Specific conditions:

1- For the admission into the cycle of Senior Sports and Physical Education Teachers (MPEPS)

- For external candidates, be holder of the Baccalaureate diploma of General Secondary Education (all series) or the General Certificate of Education Advanced Level (GCE-A/L) in two papers excluding "religious knowledge" or any other recognized equivalent certificate;
- For internal candidates, be a Sports and Physical Education Teacher (MEPS) with at least 3 (three) years of seniority as at 1st January 2020 or be a civil servant of the Armed Forces, Police and Penitentiary Administration, fulfilling the same specific conditions required from external candidates and with at least 3 (three) years seniority as at 1st January 2020.
- 2- For admission into the cycle of Sports and Physical Education Teacher (MEPS)
- For external candidates, be holder of the Probatoire certificate of General Secondary Education (all series) or both the General Certificate of Education Ordinary Level (GCEO/L) in four papers excluding "religious knowledge" and General Certificate of Education Advance Level (GCE-A/L) in at least one paper excluding "religious knowledge" or any other recognized equivalent certificate.
- For internal candidates, be Assistant Sports and Physical Education Teacher with at least 3 (three) years of seniority as at 1st January 2020 or be a civil servant of the Armed Forces, Police and Penitentiary Administration, fulfilling the same specific conditions

required from external candidates and with at least 3 (three) years seniority as at 1st January 2020

Article 3.- FILE COMPOSITION.

Candidates' complete files shall be submitted, against a receipt, at the Ministry of the Public Service and Administrative Reform, Department of State Human Resources Development, (4th floor, Rooms 405 and 409) or in all Regional Delegations of the Public Service, latest Friday 7 August 2020.
