PRESS RELEASE

THE MINISTER DELEGATE AT THE PRESIDENCY IN CHARGE OF DEFENCE HEREBY INFORMS:

Young male Cameroonians who are interested in building a career with the Defence Forces, that there will be a special recruitment of 2,200 elite commandos for the Rapid Intervention Battalion (BIR). The recruitment will run from February 1 to March 14, 2021 in the headquarters of the ten administrative regions of the country.

I- CONDITIONS TO BE FULFILLED BY CANDIDATES

- Be of Cameroonian nationality;
- Be at least 18 years old on January 1, 2021 and at most 23 years old on December 31, 2021 (that is, must be born between December 31, 1998 for the oldest and January 1, 2003 for the youngest);
 - Have a clean criminal record;
 - Be single and have no child in their care;
 - Be of good moral standing;
- Be physically fit to carry out the prescribed medical, intellectual and athletic tests;
- Be holder of at least the CEP or the FSLC or an equivalent certificate. However, it is highly recommended that candidates submit their highest certificates;
 - Be at least 1.66 metres tall.

II- COMPOSITION OF APPLICATION FILE

- A handwritten application bearing a **1,000 CFA francs fiscal stamp**, signed by the candidate and addressed to: The Minister Delegate at the Presidency in Charge of Defence;
 - A certified true copy of birth certificate not more than three months old;
 - A certified true copy of the required certificate;
 - An attestation of presentation of original of the certificate;
 - A certificate of non-conviction not more than three months old,

A duly filled out information sheet;

A certificate of celibacy;

- Four (4) passport size photographs (4X4) of the candidate bearing his name on the back;

An uncertified photocopy of the National Identity Card or its receipt;

A certificate of Cameroonian nationality issued by the competent services;

 An envelope bearing a 500 CFA francs postal stamp and the candidate's address;

A curriculum vitae signed by the candidate;

 A sum of 5,000 CFA francs, representing the cost of participation in the recruitment (to be paid during the medical aptitude examination);

 A sum of 20,000 CFA francs, representing the cost of thorough medical examinations, to be paid by candidates who have passed the preselection tests.

Candidates are reminded of the following:

- The obligation to go for the recruitment only in the headquarter of their region of origin;

- The prohibition to marry before three (03) years of active service;

- The obligation to present only authentic certificates under penalty of prosecution.

In addition, successful candidates must present the original of their National Identity Card prior to entry to the BIR Commando Training Centre, failing which they shall be dismissed from the recruitment.

The complete application files should be submitted **preferably** at the Command Posts (CP) of the Military Sectors of the candidates' regions of origin, or at the Command Posts of the Military Sectors of their regions of residence, from **Monday December 21, 2020 to Friday January 15, 2021 at 3:30pm**, prompt.
