PRESS RELEASE

THE MINISTER DELEGATE AT THE PRESIDENCY IN CHARGE OF DEFENCE
HEREBY INFORMS:

Young Cameroonians of both sexes who are interested in building a career with the Defence Forces, that a competitive entrance examination into the Combined Services Military Academy (E.M.I.A) shall be organised on **8th and 9th May 2021** at the unique centre of Yaoundé. Fields of study and conditions to be fulfilled are as follows:

I – GENERAL CONDITIONS TO BE FULFILLED

- Be of Cameroonian nationality;
- Be single without dependent children;
- Exercise their civil rights;
- Be of good moral standing;
- Have a minimum height of 1.67 metres for boys and 1.60 metres for girls;
- Be physically fit.

II – SPECIFIC CONDITIONS BY TRUNK

1 - TRONC "A"

(Direct recruitment of civilians holding a Baccalauréat)

Number of places: 125

- Be born between 31st December 1998 and 1st January 2003;
- Be holder of a Baccalauréat or GCE Advanced Level obtained in at least two subjects excluding Religious Studies;
- Must have completed successfully at least one year of undergraduate studies.

2 - TRONC "C"

(Direct recruitment of civilians holding a Bachelor's Degree or a certificate in Engineering)

Number of places: 40

- Be born between 31st December 1995 and 1st January 2003;
- Be holder of a Bachelor's Degree or a certificate in Engineering. However, applicants shall be obliged to chose from among the following options on which the exam shall be written: **Computer Science, Civil Engineering, Telecommunications, Law, Economics, Mathematics, Social Sciences, Biology,**

Physics, International Relations, History, Geography, Bilingual Letters, Political Science, Economics and Management.

3 - TRONC "B1"

(Recruitment of combined services personnel and non-commissioned officers holding a Baccalauréat)

Number of places: 15

- Be born as from 31st December 1991;
- Be holder of a Baccalauréat or GCE Advanced Level obtained in at least three subjects excluding Religious Studies;
- Have at least 5 years of service with the Armed Forces.

4 - TRONC "B2(b)"

(Recruitment of combined services personnel and non-commissioned officers holding a Bachelor's Degree or a certificate in Engineering)

Number of places: 5

- Be born as from 31st December 1989;
- Be holder of a Bachelor's Degree or a certificate in Engineering. However, applicants shall be obliged to choose from among the following options on which the exam shall be written: **Computer Science, Civil Engineering, Telecommunications, Law, Economics, Mathematics, Social Sciences, Biology, Physics, International Relations, History, Geography, Bilingual Letters, Political Science, Economics and Management;**
- Have at least 5 years of service with the Armed Forces.

5 - TRONC "D(b)"

(Direct recruitment of civilians holding a Doctorate Degree in general medicine, pharmacy, dental surgery or veterinary medicine)

Number of places: 10

- Be born as from 31st December 1991;
- Be holder of a Doctorate Degree in Medicine.

6 - TRONC "D(c)"

(Direct recruitment of specialised civil medical officers)

Number of places: 5

- Be born as from 31st December 1986;
- Be holder of a certificate in a specialised medical field.

III - COMPOSITION OF FILE

- An A4 envelope bearing a 1,000 CFA francs fiscal stamp, with the following handwritten information: Name and surname, complete address and selected trunk;
- A handwritten application bearing a 1,000 CFA francs fiscal stamp, signed by the applicant and addressed to the Minister Delegate at the Presidency in Charge of Defence;

- A certified true copy of birth certificate, not more than 3 months old;
- A certified true copy of the required certificate;
- A certified true copy of attestation of completion of studies or transcript of the first year of undergraduate studies (for Trunk A applicants);
- An attestation of presentation of the original of the required certificate;
- A Curriculum Vitae;
- A Certificate of Nationality issued by a competent authority (magistrate);
- A Certificate of Non-Conviction issued by a competent authority (magistrate) not more than 03 months ago;
- A Certificate of Celibacy (for civilian applicants);
- A short file (for military applicants);
- A cardboard folder;
- An information sheet to be obtained from the Human Resource Department upon submission of the file.

Candidates shall pay a sum of **20,000 (twenty thousand) CFA francs** against a receipt, representing the examination fees, to the Human Resource Department of the Ministry of Defence.

Complete application files shall be submitted to the Human Resource Department of the Ministry of Defence no later than **Friday 19 February 2021 at 3:30pm.** /-
