Organising the competitive examination into the third year of the Conception Engineering training Cycle (03 years) of the School of Chemical Engineering and Mineral Industries (SCEMI) of the University of Ngaoundéré, and stating the number of places stipulated in the 2020/2021 academic year.

Mindful of the Order N°. 93/028 of 19 January 1993 fixing the administrative and academic organisation of the University of Ngaoundéré ;
Mindful of the Order N°. 93/032 of 19 January 1993 fixing the financial regulations applicable to Universities;
Mindful of the Decree N°. 2005/383 of 17 October 2005 fixing the financial regulations applicable to Universities;
Mindful of the Order N°. 99/003 of 19 January 1993, modifying certain provisions of Decree N°. 79/186 of 17 May 1979 stating the amount payable as tuition fee;
Mindful of the Decree N°. 2017/402 of 27 June 2017, appointing the Rector of the University of Ngaoundéré ;
Mindful of the Order N°. 2017/585 of 24 November 2017 stating the administrative and academic organisation of the School of Chemical Engineering and Mineral Industries (EGCIM) of the University of Ngaoundéré ;

On the proposition of the Rector of the University of Ngaoundéré ;

DECIDES:

Article 1: A Competitive entrance' examination for admission of thirty (30) students into the Chemical Engineering (CE) field, in the training of Conception Engineers of the School of Chemical Engineering and Mineral Industries (EGCIM) of the University of Ngaoundéré for the 2020/2021 academic year shall take place on the Saturday 23 october 2021.

Article 2: (1) The entrance Examination mentioned in Article 1 above is open to Cameroonian of both sexes as well as to foreigners resident in Cameroon;

(2) Candidates admitted out of the CEMAC shall pay a tuition fee of One million (1000 000FCFA) each year.

Article 3: The Candidates for the entrance examination shall be holders of one of the following qualifications :

- A "licence" in Chemistry, Biochemistry, or Physics;
- The University Diploma of Technology equivalent to the field of studies solicited;
- A Bachelor's degree in Chemistry, Biochemistry and Physics;
- Any other diploma equivalent qualifications related to the programme that is recognized by the Ministry of Higher Education.

Article 4: The complete application file should comprise of the following documents:

- 1) An application form to be filled by the candidate and stamped at 1000 FCFA downloaded from the website: www.concours-egcim.cm;
- 2) A certified true photocopy of the Birth Certificate dated not more than three (03) months old;
- 3) A certified true photocopy of the required diplomas and certificates for the exam;
- 4) 04 recent passport- size photographs (4x4) ;
- 5) A medical certificate delivered by a certified health practitioner dated not more than three (03) months old;
- 6) A receipt of payment of the sum of twenty thousand (20 000) FCFA being examination fee to EGCIM of NGAOUNDERE delivered by the: **SOCIETE GENERALE CAMEROUN**, bank Code : 10003, Counter Code : 00900, bank account N°: 22090795734, RIB/code : 19. Deposit may also be done directly in any agency of the **SOCIETE GENERALE CAMEROUN** bank or via its partners of the University of Ngaoundéré notably **EXPRESS UNION** and **EXPRESS EXCHANGE**;
- 7) An A4 sized self-addressed and 500 FCFA stamped envelop.

Article 5: Completed application forms are available at and can be deposited on or before **Thursday 21 october 2021** at any of the following places:

- The Ministry of Higher Education/Directorate of Development of Higher Education at the 13th Floor,
- Directorate of EGCIM of the University of Ngaoundéré;
- The Branch of the University of Ngaoundéré in Yaoundé, Nkolbisson;
- Faculty of Science of the University of Dschang;
- Any of the Regional Delegations of the Ministry of Secondary Education (MINESEC) for Ngaoundéré, Douala, Maroua, Yaoundé, Garoua, Buea and Bafoussam.

Article 6: The Entrance examination is based on written tests on the following subjects:

Article 7: The Entrance examination into the Third Year of the School of Chemical Engineering and Mineral Industries (EGCIM) of the University of Ngaoundéré is open at the following centres: **Ngaoundéré, Douala, Maroua, Yaoundé, Dschang**.

Article 8: The written tests shall take place on the **Saturday 23 october 2021** at the centres as indicated in Article 7.

Article 9: A communiqué from the Rector of the University of Ngaoundere shall precise as needs be, for each examination centre, the venue and the organization plan for of the written tests.

Article 10: Candidates are required to present themselves to the examination centres at least one hour (01H) before the start of the first subject. They must come along with their National Identity Card or any other authentic identification document.

Article 11: The syllabus of the said entrance examination is that of the Bachelor degree level, and DUT level in force in the State Universities.

Article 12: Following the proclamation of the results, successful candidates have fifteen (15) days, from the day of effective beginning of classes to present themselves in order to complete registration formalities. Beyond this dateline, absentees would be considered as having resigned and would be replaced by those on the waiting list in the order of merit, by the decision of the Minister of State, Minister of Higher Education, on proposition of the Rector of the University of Ngaoundere.

Article 13: The Rector of the University of Ngaoundéré, the Director of the Department of University Accreditations And Quality and the Director of EGCIM Ngaoundere, are, each in its own right, responsible for the execution of this decision, which has to be enlisted and communicated in French and English everywhere where need be.
