To launch the competitive entrance examination into year one of the first cycle of the Higher Teacher Training College (ENS), University of Yaoundé I, and to fix the number of places available for the 2021/2022 academic year.

Following the proposal of the Rector of the University of Yaounde I ;

ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1: A competitive entrance examination into year one of the first cycle of the Higher Teacher Training College (ENS), University of Yaoundé I, for the 2021/2022 academic year has been launched in the following series:

Article 2 : (1) The examination shall be organised in one sitting to Cameroonians of both sexes who are holders of “Baccalauréat” or GCE Advanced Level requested in subsequent series.

- (2) The “Cameroonian languages and cultures” series shall be opened to holders of GCE A/L in at least two (2) subjects including “French” and at least four (4) GCE O/L subjects in one sitting excluding ‘Religious Knowledge’.
- (3) The “Bilingual Letters” series in ENS-Yaoundé shall be opened only to holders of GCE AL and Baccalaureat ABI series who fulfil the rest of the conditions stipulated in the present order.
- (4) The table below specifies the series of “Baccalauréat” and the subjects candidates must pass in the GCE Advanced Level, to be qualified to register for the competitive entrance examination in a given series.

Article 3: (1) Foreign candidates may be allowed to sit for the examination, under the same academic conditions and according to the number of places available, in conformity with the regulations in force.

(2) Candidates who are not civil servants must not be more than 28 years old as of January 1st 2021. Age waivers will not be granted.

Article 4: The application files shall comprise the following documents:

- A registration form available at ENS, Regional Centres of MINESEC, the MINESUP website <http://www.minesup.gov.cm> and ENS website <http://www.ens.cm>.
- A certified photocopy of the birth certificate which must not be more than three (3) months old from the date of issue;
- Photocopies of transcripts of Probatoire or GCE O/L and Baccalauréat or GCE A/L signed or certified by the competent boards as well as results slips;

A certified true photocopy of Baccalauréat or GCE A/L or equivalent diploma recognised by the Minister of Higher Education, which must not be more than three (3) months old from the date of issue, or a certificate of achievement signed or certified by the competent academic authority.

Candidates preparing for the Baccalauréat or GCE A/L for the 2020/2021 session shall present their diploma in due time. They will be required to present evidence of success,

- attested by the competent authority and within a specific time limit, if they are successful in the entrance examination.
- A medical certificate issued by a medical officer, from the Administration, testifying that the candidate is physically and medically fit for teaching. It should particularly specify that the candidate does not suffer from serious physiological deficiencies in his/her diction, hearing, sight and mobility;
- A certificate of non-conviction which must not be more than three (3) months old from the date of issue;
- A receipt upon payment of twenty thousand (20,000) CFA as registration fees delivered either by Express Union or MTN Mobile Money or by the UBA - account N° 10033-05211-11004000007-50. No other method of payment will be accepted;
- One A4 self-addressed stamped envelope;
- Two passport-size photographs;



- An authorisation to sit for the examination issued by the Minister of Basic Education, the Minister of Secondary Education or the Minister of Higher Education, for candidates working in these Ministries.

Article 5: Holders of foreign diplomas shall submit either a true copy of the ministerial order granting equivalence or a receipt showing that they have submitted an application for equivalence in the Ministry of Higher Education. These documents must be issued by the Minister of Higher Education. Such candidates can be finally admitted into ENS only if they are granted equivalence for their foreign diplomas or certificates within the date limit set out by the competent authority.

Article 6 : Money paid as registration fee for the examination stated in Article 4 above will be non-refundable.

Article 7 : Complete application files should be submitted to the Admission Office of ENS latest **17th August 2021** and **11th August 2021** for regional centres.

Article 8 : The selection through a written examination shall comprise the following components:

- Academic performance representing 25% of the total assessment;
- Two written papers representing 75% of the total assessment;

Article 9: Marks for academic performance shall be distributed on the basis of:

- the candidate's age ;
- the number of years spent in secondary school;
- candidate's marks obtained in Probatoire, GCE O/L and in Baccalaureat or GCE A/L.

Article 10: The written papers will take place on **Thursday, August 19th 2021** in the following examination centers: **Bafoussam, Bertoua, Buca, Douala, Ebolowa, Maroua, Ngaoundere and Yaoundé.**

Article 11 : The distribution of papers per series is indicated in the following table:

- (1) The syllabuses of the competitive entrance examination in each section are the same as in the Baccalauréat or GCE A/L programmes.
- (2) Marks for each paper of the written test range from zero to twenty according to the above-mentioned coefficients. Any candidate who scores less than five on twenty shall be disqualified.
- (3) The jury shall prepare the list of successful candidates following the different series, and in order of merit.
- (4) In no circumstances will there be any report of cases considered successful related to one academic year to another.

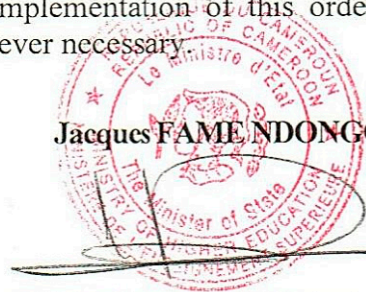
Article 12 : The composition of the jury mentioned in the above articles is specified by a particular text from the Minister of Higher Education in conformity with the regulation in force.

Article 13 : Final results shall be published by the Minister of Higher Education.

Article 14 : Fraudulent admission by non-compliance with the condition of diploma, degree, age or seniority exposes the candidate concerned to automatic exclusion at any time and without any form of procedure.

Article 15 : The Rector of the University of Yaoundé I, the Director for the Department of University Accreditations and Quality, and the Director of the Higher Teacher Training College, each in his/her own sphere, is responsible for the implementation of this order, which shall be registered and published in English and French wherever necessary.
