



## REQUIREMENTS FOR THE COMPETITIVE ENTRANCE EXAMINATION FOR 240 ROAD SAFETY EXPERTS

The entrance examination is opened to all Cameroonians or foreigners irrespective of sex in the following fields :

- Driving Licence and Road Safety Delegates (DPCSR) : 80 places, 10 of which are internal ;
- Driving Licence and Road Safety Inspectors (IPCSR) : 160 places, 20 of which are internal .

### I - CONDITIONS

Candidates must fulfill the following conditions :

#### I.1 EXTERNAL CANDIDATES

- Should be a holder of a category B driving licence;
- Should be a holder of a Baccalaureat/ GCE A-L or any recognised equivalent certificate;
- Should be at least 19 and at most 32 years by the deadline to submit files.

#### I.2 INTERNAL CANDIDATES

- Should be a holder of a category B driving licence;
- Should have at least five (05) years of work experience ;
- Should be a holder of a Baccalaureat/ GCE A-L or any recognised equivalent certificate ;
- Should be at least 19 and at most 45 years by the deadline to submit files.

#### I.3 FOR FOREIGN CANDIDATES

- Should be a holder of a category B driving licence;
- Should be a holder of a Baccalaureat/ GCE A-L or any recognised equivalent certificate;
- Should be at least 19 and at most 32 years by the deadline to submit files.;
- Should have a passport or a residence permit whose validity extends through the period of the training.

### II - CANDIDATE'S APPLICATION FILE

Candidates' complete application files should be submitted in Regional Delegations of Transport latest June 17 2022, and should carry the following documents :

- A registration form to be downloaded from the website of the Ministry of Transport or collected when submitting files :

- A 1000 FCFA stamped hand written application addressed to the Minister of Transport stating clearly the training cycle being applied for ;
  - Six (06) recent 4x4 colour/white background photographs carrying candidates' names, date and place of birth at the back ;
    - An attestation of presentation of the original of the required certificate ;
    - A certified copy of the required certificate ;
    - A certified copy of the birth certificate ;
    - A certified copy of the national identity card ;
    - A certified copy of the residence permit whose validity exceeds the training period for foreign candidates ;
    - A certified copy of the driving licence ; Foreign candidates should include a certificate of authenticity of the driving licence;
    - A medical certificate signed by a public service physician, **attesting that, the candidate is physically and mentally apt to exercise the profession of road safety expert**, in relation to both light and heavy duty car driving ;
    - A large 500 FCFA stamped envelope (postal stamp) carrying the address of the candidate;
    - A certificate of non-conviction (bulletin No. 3) not more than three months old ;
    - An attestation of effective presence signed by hierarchy for internal candidates not more than three (03) months old ;
    - A receipt justifying the payment of 25000 (twenty five thousand) CFAF registration fee to the Regional delegate of Transport for external candidates and 40000 (forty thousand) FCFA for internal candidates.
- NB :** - All certified documents must be at most three (03) months old from the date of signature ;
- Holders of a CAPEC (Professional Aptitude Certificate for the Teaching of Vehicle Driving) with a category « C » driving licence, who fulfill the conditions for this exam will be admitted directly into level 2 on file study.

### IV- LOCATION AND DURATION OF TRAINING

The training will be carried out in the Sub regional Institute for Road Safety and Research (ISSERR) located in Yaounde for a period of :

- Three (03) years for Driving Licence and Road Safety Delegates (DPCSR);
- Two (02) years for Driving Licence and Road Safety Inspectors (IPCSR).
