



I-REQUIREMENTS FOR THE COMPETITIVE EXAMINATION TO TRAIN 240 ROAD SAFETY EXPERTS

The competitive examination is opened to all Cameroonians or foreigners of both sex in the following departments:

- Driver's licence and road safety delegates (DPCSR): 80 seats including 10 internal;
- Driver's licence and road safety inspectors (IPCSR): 160 seats including 20 internal.

I- REQUIREMENTS

Candidates must fulfill the following requirements:

I.1 EXTERNAL CANDIDATES

- should be a holder of a category "B" driving licence;
- should be a holder of a Baccalauréat, GCE/AL or any other recognized equivalent diploma;
- should be at least 19 and at most 32 years old by the date of the examination.

I.2 INTERNAL CANDIDATES

- should be a holder of a category "B" driving licence;
- should have worked for at least five (5) years;
- should be a holder of a Baccalauréat, GCE/AL or any other recognized equivalent diploma;
- should be at most 45 years old by the date of the examination.

I.3 FOR FOREIGN CANDIDATES

- should be a holder of a category "B" driving licence;
- should be at least 19 and at most 32 years old by the date of the examination ;
- should be a holder of a Baccalauréat, GCE/AL or any other recognized equivalent diploma;
- should have a passport or a residence permit whose validity extends through the period of the training.

II - CANDIDATE FILE

Complete file of candidates should be submitted in Regional Delegations of Transport or in the Institut Sous-régional de Sécurité Routière et de Recherches (ISSERR), for transmission, latest 16 June 2023, and should carry the following documents:

- a registration form to be downloaded from the website www.concours.mintransports.cm or collected when submitting files;

- a 1500 CFAF stamped handwritten application addressed to the Minister of Transport and stating the training cycle being applied for;
- six (6) recent passport size colour/white background photographs carrying candidate's names, date and place of birth at the back;
- an attestation of presentation of the original of the required certificate;
- a certified copy of the required certificate;
- a certified copy of the birth certificate;
- a certified copy of the national identity card;
- a certified copy of the residence permit whose validity exceeds the training period for external candidates;
- a certified copy of the driving licence; - foreign candidates should include an authentication certificate for the driving licence;
- a medical certificate signed by a public service doctor **attesting that, the candidate is physically and mentally fit to exercise the profession of road safety expert, in relation to both light and heavy duty car driving;**
- a large 500 Fcfa stamped envelope (postal stamp) carrying the address of the candidate;
- a certificate of non-conviction (bulletin No. 3) not less than three (3) months old;
- an attestation of effective presence signed by hierarchy for internal candidates not less than three (3) months old;
- A receipt justifying the payment of 25000 (twenty five thousand) CFAF registration fee to the Regional Delegate of Transport for External candidates and 40000 (forty thousand) CFAF for internal candidates.

NB : - All certified documents must be at most three (3) months old;

- For candidates who fulfil the requirements for this examination who are holders of the CAPEC (professional Aptitude Certificate for the teaching of Vehicle Driving) and a category "C" driving licence, their admission will be made directly into year 2 after a study of their files.

IV- LOCATION AND DURATION OF TRAINING

The training will be carried out in the Institut Sous-régional de Sécurité Routière et de Recherches (ISSERR) located in Yaounde for a period of:

- Three (3) years for driving licence and road safety delegates (DPCSR);
- Two (2) years for driving licence and road safety inspectors (IPCSR).
